We finish up with Hebrews in August. It has been a tremendous blessing to study this letter so thoroughly. Some say that Hebrews is the Leviticus of the New Testament, or at least that Hebrews sheds light on the purpose of Leviticus in the redemptive plan of God. As we have stated, Hebrews is written to Hebrews to tell them to stop being so Hebrew. We have learned much in this letter, but I think the main lesson is that as church people, we need to think more in terms of being focused on Jesus and the gospel than on church and religion. So the author of the letter could be saying to church people to stop being church people and just be Jesus people. Now that's a great lesson!

As God's people we are called to unite into one family, worshipping one Lord for one mission and one goal. Each lesson will explore an aspect in the church in which God has called us to be one! Dear Church,

Sunday morning choir rehearsals will begin back August 7<sup>th</sup>. If you have not been a part of the choir and would like to join us, please come to rehearsals at 7:30 pm on Wednesdays. Nursery is provided and we are normally done at 8:30. Also, the upcoming songs are on the church app under the choir songs tab. Please start listening to them so we can learn them faster.

As the fall season approaches, we are in the process of planning our Singing Christmas Tree program. It is scheduled for the night of December 8<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm. For the church to have this program, we need a minimum of 40 singers who can stand for the duration of the service and up to 15 more individuals who can sit while they sing. If you are interested in being a part of this night, please see me now.

Our capital improvement is still moving forward. However, as a way of information, several maintenance issues had to be addressed last month:

1. We replaced the Bus barn door with a motorized lift motor at a cost of \$4,900.00.
2. We had to pump out our septic tanks for \$1,500.00
3. We had to service our back flow service lines for \$1,685.00.
4. We replaced both of our septic pumps for \$6,100.00.

The issues were not planned but required due to the age of the property. With all this said, please continue to tithe and pray about giving to the capital improvement fund.

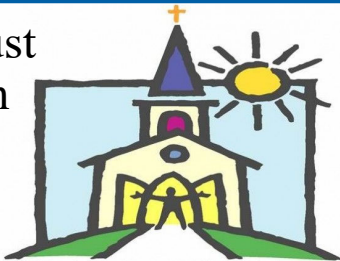
