As many of you may have heard, our church building has foundational issues. It has been brought to our attention we have problems with water saturation of our concrete slab. The flooring company determined that the entire foundation is at least 85% humidity. Per code, this level of moisture prevents any company from installing flooring, not to mention that if we were to install flooring, we would develop mold and mildew issues. We hired a *forensic engineer* to diagnose our problems, and he discovered several issues that contribute to the excess water. The building and grounds committee is developing a plan to move the water away from the building that includes replacing the entire failed gutter system, installing a new drainage system to move all water completely away from the building, leveling sidewalks that have sunk, and re-grading the land around the church to slope away from the building.

This is the correct path to address our issues but will require funds than we currently do not have on hand. We plan to repair these issues without securing a loan. As such, we have begun a fund-raising effort. If you feel led to make a contribution or even an extra monthly gift, you can do so with a check marked "Capital Improvement Campaign" or give online under the category "Capital Improvement Campaign." God has blessed us over the years by providing funds for us to deal with unexpected issues each year.

Although we have spent more than our planned yearly budget for the last 3 years, this was a result of the extra facilities expenses added to our regularly budgeted expenses. Over the last 5 years we have been able to install new flat roofs, replace several old HVAC units, repair and reseal the metal roof, install a new sound system, update our technology to accommodate online streaming, and install a new playground. This represents over \$200,000 of non-budgeted expense over the last 5 years. Praise the Lord for enabling us to be good stewards with the facilities that He has given us! If God gave us the funds in the past, we can be confident that He will provide them again.

Pray! Give! Pray some more!
