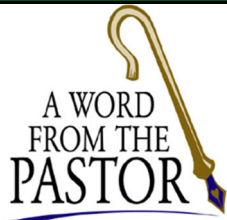

As I was praying about what to write this month, the theme of justification kept occurring to me through my Bible study and prayer life, and I even noticed a book that was out of place in my study that was entitled *Justification from Eternity*. I thought to myself, “Surely we understand justification.” Then I felt the Lord prick my heart. Yes, we know about justification. It is the process by which God makes us to be in right standing before Him. It is the process in which God cleanses us from our sin, all sin, and makes us righteous. We know that justification is necessary for salvation. Justification comes to us through two acts that are part of the same process. God makes us right, first, by dealing with our guilt and penalty. We are sinners and cannot stand before God unless that sin debt is paid. Jesus died on the cross in our place to pay our penalty and remove the sin debt from our lives. While this act cleanses us of our sin, it leaves us neutral before God. Nothing needs to be paid, but we are still left with no righteousness. The second act that makes us right before God is that Jesus imputes (gives us) His righteousness. **Genesis 15:6** says that Abraham believed God and it was credited to him as righteousness. When we accept the work of Christ on the cross by faith, he makes us righteous through giving us His righteousness. And when we stand before God, he sees us as if we are Christ, free from sin and having perfect works of righteousness to our credit, through Christ.

No one will be saved without being justified before God. We know this, but do we fully understand it? Do we fully apply this idea to our daily lives? We had nothing to offer God, and he gave us everything. So why am I writing about this in this newsletter? **Two reasons: first**, we must come to grips through our walk with God just how far God had to stoop to save wretched sinners like us. Oh Lord Jesus, thank you for making me right in your Father’s sight! Spend some time meditating on the theme of justification and offer deep and passionate praise to God for this miraculous work in our lives. **Second**, people that we see and pass by everyday are in desperate need of justification. They will not be saved without it! And they will spend eternity in Hell without someone taking time to share the gospel with them. Pray for a lost friend today! Pray for a lost stranger, and pray that God will put that person in your path so that you can share the gospel. We are called to make disciples. I pray that every member of our church would make a diligent effort to share the gospel with someone every week. Let’s get busy praising and sharing the good news of justification by faith alone in Christ alone! It is the only way of salvation!

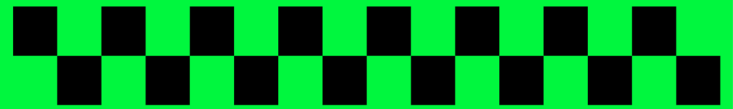
