Let's just seek Him, and He will direct our path! **Finally, we must resist Satan!** He is crouching at the door of our church waiting for us to give him a chance to come in and destroy what God is seeking for ENBC. Again, don't fall for it! This is God's church, not Satan's. Not mine ... and not yours! We must strive together for God's glory, honor, holiness, and purpose! Nothing can stop our great God when His people work together for His purpose! Let's do this! Together!
