Key Question: How can we be so sure?

1. God _____ His Promises.

1 Kings 8:56 (NLT), “Praise the Lord who has given rest to his people Israel, just as he promised. Not one word has failed of all the wonderful promises he gave through his servant Moses.”

Dt. 7:9 (NLT), “Understand, therefore, that the Lord your God is indeed God. He is the faithful God who keeps

2 Peter 1:4, “And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world’s corruption caused by human desires.”

Examples of God’s Promises to You:

- John 14:3, “I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am.”
- Hebrews 13:5, “God has said, “I will never fail you. I will never abandon you.”
- Galatians 6:9, “So let’s not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don’t give up.”
- Hebrews 6:10, “For God is not unjust. He will not forget how hard you have worked for him and how you have shown your love to him by caring for other believers, as you still do. “

2. God _____ What He Starts.

Philippians 1:6 (NLT), “And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns.”

Philippians 2:13, “For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him.”

Hebrews 12:2, “We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith. Because of the joy awaiting him, he endured the cross, disregarding its shame. Now he is seated in the place of honor beside God’s throne.”

Revelation 22:13, “I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End.”

Eph 4:30, “And do not bring sorrow to God’s Holy Spirit by the way you live. Remember, he has identified you as his own, guaranteeing that you will be saved on the day of redemption.”

3. God _____ Those He Saves.

Hebrews 7:25 (NLT), “Therefore he is able, once and forever, to save those who come to God through him. He lives forever to intercede with God on their behalf.”

Jude 24, “Now all glory to God, who is able to keep you from falling away and will bring you with great joy into his glorious presence without a single fault.”

John 10:27-30, “My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one can snatch them away from me, for my Father has given them to me, and he is more powerful than anyone else. No one can snatch them from the Father’s hand. The Father and I are one.”

4. God _____ me to _____ Him completely for my eternal security.

Acts 16:29-32, “The jailer called for lights and ran to the dungeon and fell down trembling before Paul and Silas. Then he brought them out and asked, “Sirs, what must I do to be saved?” They replied, “Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved.”

John 14:1, ““Don’t let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me.”

Mark 9:24 “I do believe, but help me overcome my unbelief!”
