In what ways do you think he is correct? What are some examples?

The key passage for "witness:

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Acts 1: 8

A "witness" is a person who gives evidence. As a Christian, what "evidence" are we to give to those who do not know Christ?

What does it mean to "live different?"

The Apostle Paul gives instructions to Christians about their interactions with nonChristians:

Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; Make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.

Colossians 4:5- 6

How can you practically live out this instruction?

How difficult is it to see everyone "through the eyes of Christ?"

How equipped are you to tell God's story and your story?

"But in your hearts, revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope you have. But do this with gentleness and respect."

1 Peter 3: 15

How equipped are you to give answers when asked about your faith or issues in culture?

Was there a “signal of transcendence” in your life when you first trusted Christ as your savior?

What examples of people sharing their faith were especially helpful to you? How will you pray and live differently to be a witness for Christ?

Make a list of family and friends whom you want to become followers of Christ.

Pray for God to send people, books, movies, and other messages to pique their minds and hearts with the message of God’s love in Christ. Ask Him for the opportunity for you to be a “witness,” too.
