The Book of James Temptation

James 1:13-15 (NIV) "When tempted, no one should say, 'God is tempting me.' For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; ¹⁴but each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. ¹⁵Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death."

How to Win over Temptation:

1. Don't let temptation catch you by <u>surprise</u>.

James 1:13_a (NIV) "When tempted ..."

1 Corinthians 10:13_a (NIV) "No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind."

2. Refuse to play the <u>blame game</u>.

James 1:13 (NIV) "When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone ..."

3. Identify what triggers temptation.

James 1:14 (NIV) "... each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed."

Lamentations 3:40 (NIV) "Let us examine our ways and test them, and let us return to the LORD."

1 Corinthians 10:12 (NIV) "So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall!"

4. Recognize that sin follows a <u>predictable</u> pattern.

2 Corinthians 2:11_b (NIV) "For we are not unaware of his [the Devil's] schemes."

James 1:14-15 (NIV) "... each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. ¹⁵Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death."

James 1:14a (ESV) "But each person is tempted when he is lured ..."

Satan dangles the bait.

James 1:14a (NIV) "... but each one is tempted when, by his own evil desire ..."

We swim around the hook.

James 1:14 (NIV) "... but each one is tempted when, by his own evil desire he is dragged away and enticed."

We take the bait.

James 1:15_a (NIV) "Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin"

We suffer the consequences.

James 1:15_b (NIV) "... and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death."

5. Refocus your attention on the goodness of God.

James 1:16-17 (NIV) "Don't be deceived, my dear brothers and sisters. ¹⁷Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows."

Psalm 84:11 (NIV) "... no good thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless."

Psalm 34:8 (NIV) "Taste and see that the LORD is good ..."

Psalms 27:13 (NIV) "I will see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living."

6. Find verses that help you stand firm and use them.

James 1:18 (NIV) "He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of all he created."
