THE GOSPELS

John 4:50 (NIV) "'Go,' Jesus replied, 'your son will live.' The man took Jesus at his word and departed."

John 5:24 (NIV) "Very truly I tell you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life."

John 6:54 (NIV) "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day."

7 responses to the message of Jesus?

1. You can be offended by what Jesus says.

John 6:60-61 (NIV) "On hearing it (the teaching of Jesus), many of his disciples said, 'This is a hard teaching. Who can accept it?' ⁶¹Aware that his disciples were grumbling about this, Jesus said to them, 'Does this offend you?'"

2. You can unfollow Jesus because of what He says.

John 6:66 (NIV) "From this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him."

John 6:67 (NIV) "'You do not want to leave too, do you?' Jesus asked the Twelve."

John 6:68 (NIV) "Simon Peter answered him, 'Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life."

3. You can try to silence the message of Jesus.

John 7:1 (NIV) "After this, Jesus went around in Galilee. He did not want to go about in Judea because the Jewish leaders there were looking for a way to kill him."

4. You can ridicule the message of Jesus.

John 7:2-5 (NIV) "But when the Jewish Festival of Tabernacles was near ... "Jesus" brothers said to him, 'Leave Galilee and go to Judea, so that your disciples there may see the works you do. "No one who wants to become a public figure acts in secret. Since you are doing these things, show yourself to the world." "For even his own brothers did not believe in him."

5. You can hate the message of Jesus.

John 7:6-7 (NIV) "Therefore Jesus told them, 'My time is not yet here; for you any time will do. ⁷The world cannot hate you, but it hates me because I testify that its works are evil."

6. You can be silent about what Jesus says.

John 7:10-11 (NIV) "However, after his brothers had left for the festival, he went also, not publicly, but in secret. ¹¹Now at the festival the Jewish leaders were watching for Jesus and asking, 'Where is he?'"

John 7:12 (NIV) "Among the crowds there was widespread whispering about him. Some said, 'He is a good man.' Others replied, 'No, he deceives the people.'"

John 7:13 (NIV) "But no one would say anything publicly about him for fear of the leaders."

7. You can receive the message with enthusiasm.

John 7:14-16 (NIV) "Not until halfway through the festival did Jesus go up to the temple courts and begin to teach. ¹⁵The Jews there were amazed and asked, 'How did this man get such learning without having been taught?' ¹⁶Jesus answered, 'My teaching is not my own. It comes from the one who sent me.'"
