What is life's biggest question?

1. Who is Jesus Christ?

Matthew 16:13-14 (NIV) "When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, '<u>Who do people say</u> the Son of Man is?' ¹⁴They replied, 'Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets.'"

Matthew 16:15 (NIV) "'But what about you?' he asked. 'Who do you say I am?'"

Matthew 16:16 (NIV) "Simon Peter answered, 'You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.'"

Mark 15:39 (NIV) "And when the centurion, who stood there in front of Jesus, heard his cry and saw how he died, he said, <u>'Surely this man was the Son of God!</u>"

Luke 23:42-43 (NIV) "Then he said, 'Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.' ⁴³Jesus answered him, 'I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in paradise.'"

2. What is His mission?

Matthew 16:18 (NIV) "And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock <u>I will build my church</u>, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it."

John 10:27-30 (NIV) "My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they <u>follow me</u>. ²⁸I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand. ²⁹My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand. ³⁰<u>I and the Father are one</u>."

John 3:16-17 (NIV) "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁷For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to <u>save the world</u> through him."

3. Why did He come?

Matthew 16:21 (NIV) "From that time on Jesus began to explain to his disciples that <u>he must go</u> to Jerusalem and suffer many things at the hands of the elders, chief priests and teachers of the law, and that <u>he must be killed</u> and on the third day be raised to life. "

Hebrews 9:22 (NIV) "In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and <u>without the shedding of</u> blood there is no forgiveness."

1 Peter 2:24 (NIV) "He himself <u>bore our sins in his body</u> on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by <u>his wounds you have been healed."</u>

2 Corinthians 5:21 (NIV) "God made him who had no sin <u>to be sin for us</u>, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God."

4. How should we then live?

Matthew 16:24 (NIV) "Then Jesus said to his disciples, 'If anyone would come after me, he must <u>deny himself</u> and take up his cross and <u>follow me</u>.'"

Matthew 16:26 (NIV) "What good will it be for a man if he gains the whole world, <u>yet forfeits his soul</u>? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul?"

Matthew 16:25 (NIV) "For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will find it."

Romans 10:9-10 (NIV) "That if you <u>confess with your mouth</u>, 'Jesus is <u>Lord</u>,' and <u>believe in your heart</u> that God raised him from the dead, you will be <u>saved</u>. ¹⁰For it is with your <u>heart</u> that you <u>believe</u> and are <u>justified</u>, and it is with your <u>mouth</u> that you confess and are <u>saved</u>."
