Doers James 1:21-27

How Do We Become Doers of the Word?

1. Properly prepare yourself

James 1:21 (NIV) "Therefore, get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can save you."

James 1:21 (MSG) "So throw all spoiled virtue and cancerous evil in the garbage. In simple humility, let our gardener, God, landscape you with the Word, making a salvation-garden of your life."

2 Corinthians 7:1_b (NIV) "... let us purify ourselves from everything that contaminates body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God."

2. <u>Read</u> it

James 1:22_a (NIV) "Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves."

James 1:22 (NIV) "Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says."

3. Reflect what we read

James 1:23-24 (NIV) "Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror ²⁴and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like."

James 1:25 (NIV) "But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do."

4. <u>Respond</u> to what you read

James 1:26 (NIV) "Those who consider themselves religious and yet do not keep a tight rein on their tongues deceive themselves, and their religion is worthless."

James 1:27 (NIV) "Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world."

Psalm 68:5 (NIV) "A father to the fatherless, a defender of widows, is God in his holy dwelling."

Matthew 7:24-27 (NIV) "Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. ²⁵The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. ²⁶But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. ²⁷The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; and it fell with a great crash."
