# Chapter 14

# WHAT DO YOU DO WHEN CHRISTIANS DISAGREE?

#### Principle #1. Don't argue with people over disputable matters.

Romans 14:1 (NIV) "Accept the one whose faith is weak, without quarreling over disputable matters."

**Romans 14:2-3 (NIV)** "One person's faith allows them to eat anything, but another, whose faith is weak, eats only vegetables. <sup>3</sup>The one who eats everything must not treat with **contempt** the one who does not, and the one who does not eat everything must not judge the one who does, for God has accepted them."

Romans 14:4a (NIV) "Who are you to judge someone else's servant?"

#### Principle #2. Don't insist that your way is the only right way.

**Romans 14:5 (NIV)** "One person considers one day more sacred than another; another considers every day alike. Each of them should be fully convinced in their own mind."

**Romans 14:6 (NIV)** "Whoever regards one day as special does so to the Lord. Whoever eats meat does so to the Lord, for they give thanks to God; and whoever abstains does so to the Lord and gives thanks to God."

**Romans 14:7-8 (NIV)** "For none of us lives for ourselves alone, and none of us dies for ourselves alone. <sup>8</sup>If we live, we live for the Lord; and if we die, we die for the Lord. So, whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord."

#### Principle #3. We will all stand before God's judgment seat.

**Romans 14:10-11 (NIV)** "You, then, why do you judge your brother or sister? Or why do you treat them with contempt? For we will all stand before God's judgment seat. <sup>11</sup>It is written: "As surely as I live,' says the Lord, 'every knee will bow before me; every tongue will acknowledge God.""

Romans 14:12 (NIV) "So then, each of us will give an account of ourselves to God."

#### Principle #4. Our actions are limited by the impact they have on others.

**Romans 14:13 (NIV)** "Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in the way of a brother or sister."

**Romans 14:15 (NIV)** "If your brother or sister is distressed because of what you eat, you are no longer acting in love. Do not by your eating destroy someone for whom Christ died."

#### Unity matters to God!

**Romans 14:17-18 (NIV)** "For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit, <sup>18</sup>because anyone who serves Christ in this way is pleasing to God and receives human approval."

**Romans 14:19-21 (NIV)** "Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification. <sup>20</sup>Do not destroy the work of God for the sake of food. All food is clean, but it is wrong for a person to eat anything that causes someone else to stumble. <sup>21</sup>It is better not to eat meat or drink wine or to do anything else that will cause your brother or sister to fall."
