Your Advocate in the midst of Distress

Key Promise: Psa 4:1

I call upon you and you answered me, O God of my vindication. In distress you give enlargement, you favor me and hear my prayer. *JY*

How God can take you to your UNIQUE and GREAT Destiny despite imperfect situations and set-backs.

Many people have an 'if only' mentality. If only I had better abilities, a better personality, better education, a better family background. If only I lived in a better environment or place. The truth is that God can bless you even in an imperfect situation. Even when you are mourning, you can experience divine comfort!

What is the comfort that God is giving to those who mourn?

Matt 5:4 Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted. *NKJV*

Comfort $\pi\alpha\rho\alpha\kappa\alpha\lambda\epsilon\omega$ *parakaleō*: To call to the side of, an advocate to help, defend, counsel, guide, exhort, comfort.

Gen 37:35

And all his sons and all his daughters arose to comfort him; but he refused to be comforted, and he said, "For I shall go down into the grave to my son in mourning." Thus his father wept for him. *NKJV*

What happens when we refuse to be comforted?

Every self-defeating behavior is a result of a lie or lying emotion we believe in.

Even though it was a lie, the feelings were real. Jacob lived for years with <u>unnecessary</u> misery!

Let Him stand alongside you, taking you any distress.
