Today's Article

Making Evangelism the Focus

Evangelism is one of the clear goals of the care group ministry. One of the most destructive things that can happen in a care group is when older, mature Christians begin to join together. They don't win souls. They have the same people in the meeting week after week, month after month.

After a while, they get bored with one another and that group becomes dead. There is no growing. There is no expansion. Then they begin to sit around and think of better ways to run the church. They come up with all kinds of plans on what the pastor should be doing. They become cancerous.

The care group ministry is designed for evangelism. One of the most powerful tools of evangelism is what we call in our church "friendship evangelism". When a person is first saved, (especially for the first six months), it is the most powerful evangelistic time in his life. Why is that? Why is a new Christian such a good soul winner? Because all of his friends are unbelievers.

One of the great soul winning opportunities is when you take a newly trained leader, and find a new convert in your church who is excited about Jesus and excited about the church. Let the leader hold a care group in the new convert's house. Then you have an explosion of growth. That convert will bring his unsaved friends to the meeting. They will get saved and in turn win more new people. We need to constantly be reaching people.
