A. Bible by Olive Tree

1. Comparing	versions	of	the	Bible

Open two windows
Different versions
See Sync options
– Main window leads

Literal translation:

Literal word for word. Every word of the Scripture is God-breathed.

2 Tim 3:16 16

All Scripture is God- breathed and profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness. *LITV*

Dynamic equivalence translation:

The translators use the equivalent English ways to express the meaning of the original text. It is a thought by thought translation.

Neh 8:8

They read from the Book of the Law of God and clearly explained the meaning of what was being read, helping the people understand each passage. *NLT*

Compare these two verses in different translations:

Neh 1:11

O Lord, please hear my prayer! Listen to the prayers of those of us who delight in honoring you. Please grant me success today by making the **king** favorable to me. Put it into his heart to be kind to me." In those days I was the king's cup-bearer. *NLT*

Neh 1:11

O Lord, I pray, please let Your ear be attentive to the prayer of Your servant, and to the prayer of Your servants who desire to fear Your name; and let Your servant prosper this day, I pray, and grant him mercy in the sight of this **man**." For I was the king's cupbearer. *NKJV*

Paraphrased translation:

This is not to replace but complement your usual version in a refreshing way. The Living Bible, for instance, began in the context of Kenneth Taylor's efforts to explain the biblical text to his children during family devotions.

Prov 27:19

A mirror reflects a man's face, but what he is really like is shown by the kind of friends he chooses. *LB*

Pro 27:19

As face reflects face in the water, so the heart of man reflects a man. LITV

Phil 4:13

I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him Who infuses inner strength into me. AMP

You need ALL the above.

No translation **alone** will be able to bring out the depth of the meaning in His Word!

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more **abundantly** (?). *NKJV Strongs*

Another good dictionary:

CWSB (Complete Word Study Bible) by AMG

John 5:2

Now there is in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate a pool, which is called in Hebrew, **Bethesda** (?), having five porches. *NKJV*

Commentaries:

Give **overviews**, suggest various **interpretations**, describe **cultural**, **historical** background and **grammatical** usages.

Rom 3:24

being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus. *NKJV* Psa 22:1

My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? Why are You so far from helping Me, And from the words of My groaning? *NKJV*

Recommend:

Bible Knowledge Commentary, Walwoord

Approximate Cost:

Bibles – about US\$10 Dictionaries with Bible - US\$20 Commentaries: US\$40



Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body. *NKJV*

1 Cor 10:12

¹²Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall. *NKJV*

iPad / iPhone - using Safari:

Settings → General → Restrictions → Enable Restrictions with pincode. Set *Limit Adult Content* → Do not allow: m.youtube.com; www.vimeo.com; www.videobash.com. Keep the pincode with **you** only and **not** your **children**.

To download an application to safely use YouTube:

Apple App Store → Search: YouTube Safe (by EC Prod.) → Open App → Manage Passcode → Enter Passcode → Save → You can add additional words to block bad contents.

To use Safe Browser:

Google PlayStore → Search: *Mobicip Safe Browser* → *Install.* Open Mobicip and Login with *Email* – *block PlayStore to block downloads of any other browsers & put in Password* → Enter Mobicip Passcode – 4 digits

To change Filter Level:

Go to Mobicip Website @ <u>www.mobicip.com</u> → Login with *Email & Password* → *Edit* current profile / *Add Profile* → *Save* and *Logout*.
