Memory Verse: "Nothing at all can ever separate us from God's love." Romans 8:39, NIr

Memory Verse Puzzle
What You Need: paper or cardstock, scissors
and a marker
What You Do:

- Write out the memory verse on a piece of paper or cardstock with the marker.
 Use the scissors to cut the paper into 5-6 pieces.
- Help your preschooler put the puzzle together and say the verse aloud after it is finished.
- You can make several versions of the puzzle and challenge your kids to complete each one.

Prayer

What You Do:

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 Use this prayer prompt either right after the activities or before bed.

"Dear God, thank You for this story Jesus told. Just like that coin was very special to the woman in the story, we know that we are VERY special to You. Thank you for loving us, always. We love You, too. In Jesus' name we pray, amen."

Celebration Parade

What You Need: Various musical instruments (pots, pans, and wooden spoons work)

What You Do:

- Pass out the instruments and have everyone line up behind you.
- Wave your arms back and forth like a conductor as you lead everyone in a march around the room.
- Lower your arms as a signal for the children to stop playing and marching.
- Say God loves me and then march again!

What You Say:
"Now that was a fun
celebration parade! I love
celebrating that God loves us!
You are SO special to God,
and He loves you very much.
One more time, tell me, who
loves you? God loves me."
