Knowing the Holy Spirit and Being Filled with the Spirit

1 Corinthians 15:45b — The last Adam *became* a life-giving Spirit.

Philippians 1:19 — For I know that for me this will turn out to salvation through your petition and the bountiful supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ.

John 7:37 — Now on the last day, the great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.

38 — He who believes into Me, as the Scripture said, out of his innermost being shall flow rivers of living water.

39 — But this He said concerning the Spirit, whom those who believed into Him were about to receive; for *the* Spirit was not yet, because Jesus had not yet been glorified.

- A. The Father is the source, the Son is the course, and the Holy Spirit is the Triune God reaching and entering into the believers—1 Corinthians 13:14
- B. In resurrection, Christ became a life-giving Spirit—1 Corinthians 15:45b
- C. The Spirit of Jesus Christ with all the elements of Jesus' humanity and Christ's divinity—Philippians 1:19
- D. The Spirit of reality as our life and light—John 14:17

II. Being filled with the Spirit:

- A. We are filled with the Spirit by breathing—John 20:22
- B. We are filled with the Spirit by drinking—John 7:38-39
- C. We are filled with the Spirit by speaking and singing—Ephesians 5:19
- D. We are filled with the Spirit by walking according to the Spirit—Galatians 5:25
