Isaiah 28:10 For his words are: Rule upon rule, rule upon rule; / Line upon line, line upon line; / Here a little, there a little. (Cf. v. 13)

The Heavenly Diet — Manna

Matthew 4:4 But He answered and said, It is written, “Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out through the mouth of God.”

John 6:51 I am the living bread which came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he shall live forever; and the bread which I will give is My flesh, given for the life of the world. (Cf. vv. 57 “eats Me,” 63 “words...are spirit and life”)

Ephesians 6:17-18a And receive the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which Spirit is the word of God, by means of all prayer...

The characteristics of manna: from heaven; with the dew; in the morning; small; fine; round; white; as frost; as coriander seed; solid; its appearance like bdellium; its taste like that of fresh oil; its taste like that of wafers made with honey; good for making cakes; a mystery

Exodus 16:2 And the whole assembly of the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron in the wilderness.

3 And the children of Israel said to them, If only we had died by the hand of Jehovah in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the fleshpots, when we ate bread to the full; for you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole congregation with hunger.

4 Then Jehovah said to Moses, I will now rain bread from heaven for you; and the people shall go out and gather a day’s portion every day, that I may test them, whether or not they will walk in My law.

5 And on the sixth day when they prepare what they bring in, it will be twice as much as they gather daily.

13b and in the morning there was a layer of dew around the camp.

14 And when the layer of dew lifted, there upon the surface of the wilderness were fine round flakes, fine as the frost on the earth.

15 And when the children of Israel saw it, they said to one another, What is it? For they did not know what it was. And Moses said to them, It is the bread which Jehovah has given you to eat.

31 And the house of Israel called its name manna, and it was like coriander seed, white; and its taste was like wafers made with honey.
