His Being Triune

God Being Uniquely One

1 Corinthians 8:4b We know that an idol is nothing in the world and that there is no God but one. (Cf. Isaiah 45:5 "besides Me there is no God")

Exodus 3:14 And God said to Moses, I AM WHO I AM. And He said, Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, I AM has sent me to you. (Cf. v. 18 "Jehovah, the God of your fathers")

Matthew 1:21 And she will bear a son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for it is He who will save His people from their sins. (Cf. John 28-29 "My Lord and my God")

God Also Having the Aspect of Three

Matthew 28:19 Go therefore and disciple all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. (Cf. John 10:30 "I and the Father are one"; 2 Corinthians 3:17 "the Lord is the Spirit"; Isaiah 9:6 "a child...a Son...Mighty God...Eternal Father")

Hebrews 1:8 But of the Son, "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, and the scepter of uprightness is the scepter of Your kingdom." (Cf. 7:3 "without genealogy; having neither beginning of days nor end of life"; Isaiah 9:6 "Eternal Father"; Hebrews 9:14 "eternal Spirit")

Matthew 3:16-17 And having been baptized, Jesus went up immediately from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon Him. And behold, a voice out of the heavens, saying, This is My Son, the Beloved, in whom I have found My delight.

John 14:10a Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me? (Cf. v. 20)

God Being Triune to Dispense Himself into Man

2 Corinthians 13:14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

John 1, 14a In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. And the Word became flesh.

1 Corinthians 15:45b The last Adam [Christ] became a life-giving Spirit.

Romans 10:9 That if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Mark 16:16 He who believes and is baptized shall be saved, but he who does not believe shall be condemned.
