The Revelation and Experience of Christ

Matthew 16:16 — And Simon Peter answered and said, You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.

John 1:1 — In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:14 — And the Word became flesh and tabernacled among us (and we beheld His glory, glory as of the only Begotten from the Father), full of grace and reality.

Philippians 3:8 — But moreover I also count all things to be loss on account of the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, on account of whom I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as refuse that I may gain Christ.

I. The revelation of Christ:

- A. The person of Christ (who He is)—He is the Son of God, who is God (the complete God), and the Son of Man, who is man (the perfect man)—Matthew 16:16
- B. The work of Christ (what He does)—creating, becoming flesh, being crucified, being resurrected, ascending, fulfilling His heavenly ministry, coming again, establishing the millennial kingdom, and consummating the New Jerusalem—John 1:12
- C. We need to pursue to know Christ—Philippians 3:8, 10

II. The experience of Christ:

- A. He who is joined to the Lord is one spirit—1 Corinthians 6:17
- B. Christ being our life—Colossians 3:4
- C. Christ being the unsearchable riches—Ephesians 3:8
- D. Christ living in us—Galatians 2:20
- E. Christ being formed in us—Galatians 4:19
