³ Then Jesus told them this parable: ⁴ “Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Does he not leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? ⁵ And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders ⁶ and goes home.



Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.' ⁷ I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.



⁸ “Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins and loses one. Does she not light a lamp, sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it?
⁹ And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbors together and says, ‘Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin.’



¹⁰ In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.”

¹¹ Jesus continued: “There was a man who had two sons. ¹² The younger one said to his father, ‘Father, give me my share of the estate.’ So he divided his property between them. ¹³ “Not long after that, the younger son got together all he had, set off for a distant country and there squandered his wealth in wild living.



¹⁴ After he had spent everything, there was a severe famine in that whole country, and he began to be in need. ¹⁵ So he went and hired himself out to a citizen of that country, who sent him to his fields to feed pigs. ¹⁶ He longed to fill his stomach with the pods that the pigs were eating, but no one gave him anything.

LOSTNESS: TO BE LOST IS TO BE...

- SEPARATED FROM YOUR RIGHTFUL OWNER
- IN DANGER, WHETHER REALIZED OR NOT
- USELESS, “OUT OF CIRCULATION”



LOSTNESS: HOW IT HAPPENS...

- WE UNINTENTIONALLY WANDER AWAY FROM GOD
- CIRCUMSTANCES IN OUR LIFE (SOMETIMES OUT OF OUR CONTROL) PUSH AND PULL US TOWARDS SEPARATION FROM GOD
- WE, KNOWING THE DANGERS AS WELL AS OUR FREEDOM, CHOSE TO WALK AWAY FROM THE LIFE GOD CREATED FOR US



GOD & JESUS

- **PERSISTENT** - "UNTIL HE FINDS IT"
- **PERSONAL** - "MY"
- **PASSIONATE** - LEAVES, LIGHTS, SWEEPS,
- "FILLED WITH COMPASSION,"
"THREW HIS ARMS AROUND HIM,"
"KISSED HIM"
- **PURSUIT** - "GO AFTER," "SEARCH CAREFULLY,"
"SAW HIM," "RAN TO HIS SON"



VERY IMPORTANT MOVEMENT

- RECOGNIZED HIS TRUE CONDITION (17)
- WALKED IN THE OPPOSITE DIRECTION (18)
- CONFESSION OF HIS LOSTNESS (18)
- PLEA FOR RESTORATION (19)
- FATHER, RESTORES HIM BEYOND HIS OWN EXPECTATION (22FF)
