 The "Kingdom of Heaven" is not just a future time for which we are to wait. The "Kingdom of Heaven" is available now in the present.

 The "Kingdom of Heaven" is realized now in the "heart" of the believer but demands expression in the evil, broken world we live in.

• The world's "Kingdom of Evil" hates the "Kingdom of Heaven" and so we will feel and see the effects of this hatred in the persecution of followers of Jesus to varying degrees.

• The "Beatitudes" are not a list of laws by which we "earn" or "merit" entrance into the "Kingdom of Heaven"; they are instead a description of the repentance and the righteousness that belong to the "Kingdom of Heaven".

 This righteousness of the "Kingdom of Heaven" is not the imputed righteousness of Jesus Christ applied to us at salvation—though it is necessary—but the desire of our own heart empowered/enabled by the Spirit of God to pursue His righteousness.

Matthew 6

- ⁹ "This, then, is how you should pray:
- " 'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name,
- 10 your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
- ¹¹ Give us today our daily bread.
- ¹² Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.
