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  Corinthian/needs interpretation (2 steps)
- 4. The purposes of the two kinds of "tongues" is different evangelistic vs edification



• For Luke this marks an significant change in the plan of redemption and relates to the baptism of Jesus. The birth of the church has been officially announced.




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•This also affirms that the languages spoken by the disciples were languages not known to them and only through the presence of the Holy Spirit were they able to speak

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- 2. The mention of Rome is important the capital of this part of the world and a significant city in the rest of Acts
