Acts 20:1-38

...The Jews plotted against him when he was about to set sail for Syria, and so he decided to go back through Macedonia.
⁴He was accompanied by Sopater son of Pyrrhus from Berea, Aristarchus and Secundus from Thessalonica, Gaius from Derbe, Timothy, and Tychicus and Trophimus from the province of Asia. ⁵These men went on ahead and waited for us in Troas, ⁶but we sailed away from Philippi after the Festival of Unleavened Bread. In five days we reached them at Troas, where we spent seven days.

EUTYCHUS REVIVED AT TROAS

⁷On the first day of the week, we assembled to break bread. Paul spoke to them, and since he was about to depart the next day, he kept on talking until midnight. ⁸There were many lamps in the room upstairs where we were assembled, ⁹and a young man named Eutychus was sitting on a window sill and sank into a deep sleep as Paul kept on talking. When he was overcome by sleep, he fell down from the third story and was picked up dead. ¹⁰But Paul went down, bent over him, embraced him, and said, "Don't be alarmed, because he's alive." ¹¹After going upstairs, breaking the bread, and eating, Paul talked a long time until dawn. Then he left. ¹²They brought the boy home alive and were greatly comforted.

UNSTOPPABLE

EUTYCHUS

- Only person that God used Paul to raise from the dead. (Jesus & Peter)
- Shows Paul as a prophet in the vein of Elijah and Elisha. Word givers.
- Powerful validation of Paul's message and ministry by God.

FROM TROAS TO MILETUS

¹³We went on ahead to the ship and sailed for Assos, where we were going to take Paul on board, because these were his instructions, since he himself was going by land. ¹⁴When he met us at Assos, we took him on board and went on to Mitylene. ¹⁵Sailing from there, the next day we arrived off Chios. The following day we crossed over to Samos, and the day after, we came to Miletus.

FAREWELL ADDRESS TO THE EPHESIAN ELDERS

¹⁸When they came to him, he said to them, “You know, from the first day I set foot in Asia, how I was with you the whole time, ¹⁹serving the Lord with all humility, with tears, and during the trials that came to me through the plots of the Jews. ²⁰You know that I did not hesitate to proclaim anything to you that was profitable and to teach you publicly and from house to house. ²¹I testified to both Jews and Greeks about repentance toward God and faith in our Lord Jesus.
