

<sup>22</sup>Wives, submit to your husbands as to the Lord, <sup>23</sup>because the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church. He is the Savior of the body. <sup>24</sup>Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives are to submit to their husbands in everything.



<sup>25</sup>Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself for her <sup>26</sup>to make her holy, cleansing her with the washing of water by the word. <sup>27</sup>He did this to present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or anything like that, but holy and blameless.



<sup>28</sup>In the same way, husbands are to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. <sup>29</sup>For no one ever hates his own flesh but provides and cares for it, just as Christ does for the church, <sup>30</sup>since we are members of his body. EPHESIANS IN CHRIST

<sup>31</sup>For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two will become one flesh. <sup>32</sup>This mystery is profound, but I am talking about Christ and the church. 33To sum up, each one of you is to love his wife as himself, and the wife is to respect her husband. ### **Colossians 3:18-4:1**

<sup>18</sup>Wives, submit yourselves to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord. <sup>19</sup>Husbands, love your wives and don't be bitter toward them. <sup>20</sup>Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord. <sup>21</sup>Fathers, do not exasperate your children, so that they won't become discouraged. <sup>22</sup>Slaves, obey your human masters in everything. Don't work only while being watched, as people-pleasers, but work wholeheartedly, fearing the Lord. EPHESIANS IN CHRIST

#### **Colossians 3:18-4:1**

<sup>23</sup>Whatever you do, do it from the heart, as something done for the Lord and not for people, <sup>24</sup>knowing that you will receive the reward of an inheritance from the Lord. 
#### Mark 10:42-45

It is crucial to recognize that this passage does not represent a cultural concession to the prevailing forms of patriarchy in Roman households (as a number of modern commentators assume). This passage is countercultural at its core. Paul sets Christ as the example for both wives and husbands, but in particular the husband, as he seeks to understand how he is to exert his leadership and authority in the home.
