

When they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage at the Mount of Olives, Jesus then sent two disciples, ² telling them, "Go into the village ahead of you. At once you will find a donkey tied there with her colt. Untie them and bring them to me. ³ If anyone says anything to you, say that the Lord needs them, and EAST he will send them at once."

⁴ This took place so that what was spoken through the prophet might be fulfilled: ⁵ Tell Daughter Zion, "See, your King is coming to you, gentle, and mounted on a donkey, and on a colt, the foal of a donkey."



⁶ The disciples went and did just as Jesus directed them. ⁷ They brought the donkey and its colt; then they laid their clothes on them, and he sat on them. ⁸ A very large crowd spread their clothes on the road; others were cutting branches from the trees and spreading them on the road.

⁹ Then the crowds who went ahead of him and those who followed shouted: "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest heaven!"



When he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was in an uproar, saying, "Who is this?"
The crowds were saying, "This is the prophet Jesus from Nazareth in Galilee."

A Different KIND OF EASTER

Titus 2

For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men. ¹² It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, ¹³ while we wait for the blessed hope — the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ,

Titus 2

¹⁴ who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself a people that are his very own, eager to do what is good. 15 These, then, are the things you should teach. Encourage and rebuke with all authority. Do not let anyone despise you.

²¹ But now, apart from the law, the righteousness of God has been revealed, attested by the Law and the Prophets., ²² The righteousness of God is through faith in Jesus Christ, to all who believe, since there is no distinction.



²³ For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. ²⁴ They are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.

1. Ransom 2. Redeemed



²⁵ God presented him as an atoning sacrifice, in his blood, received through faith, to demonstrate his righteousness, because in his restraint God passed over the sins previously committed. ²⁶ God presented him to demonstrate his righteousness at the present time, so that he would be righteous and declare righteous the one who has faith in Jesus.

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Hebrews 2

¹⁷ Therefore, he had to be like his brothers and sisters in every way, so that he could become a merciful and faithful high priest in matters pertaining to God, to make atonement, for the sins of the people.

18 For since he himself has suffered when he was tempted, he is able to help those who are tempted.

For while we were still helpless, at the right time, Christ died for the ungodly. For rarely will someone die for a just person — though for a good person perhaps someone might even dare to die. But God proves his own love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

⁹ How much more then, since we have now been declared righteous by his blood, will we be saved through him from wrath.

To For if, while we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of his Son, then how much more, having been reconciled, will we be saved by his life.

And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received this reconciliation.



1 John 2

¹ My little children, I am writing you these things so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father — Jesus Christ the righteous one. ² He himself is the atoning sacrifice, for our sins, and not only for ours, but also for those of the whole world. ¹⁹ For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, ²⁰ and through him to reconcile everything to himself, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.,



Ephesians 2

¹⁶ He did this so that he might reconcile both to God in one body through the cross by which he put the hostility to death.

²⁰ He was foreknown before the foundation of the world but was revealed in these last times for you. ²¹ Through him you believe in God, who raised him from the dead and gave him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.



Galatians 1


