John 14:12 (NLT) ¹² “I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father.

Isaiah 40:31 (NLT) ³¹ But those who trust in the Lord will find new strength. They will soar high on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint.

Daniel 1- 6

- Daniel, Shadrack, Meshack, and Abednego trusted God even though they repeatedly faced presumably unanswered prayers, captivity in a foreign land, being slaves of sorts, threatened with death, and conspiracies against their lives.
- God is with His Children, His Followers. He is at work, and He is trustworthy even if things don't always make sense.

Genesis 50:20–21 (NLT) ²⁰ You intended to harm me, but God intended it all for good. He brought me to this position so I could save the lives of many people. ²¹ No, don't be afraid. I will continue to take care of you and your children.” So he reassured them by speaking kindly to them.

Lives of Jesus' disciples were full of hardship, persecution, and martyrdom – yet miracles, purpose and power.

John 14:12–14 (NLT) ¹² “I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father. ¹³ You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. ¹⁴ Yes, ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it!

2 Timothy 4:18 (NLT) ¹⁸ Yes, and the Lord will deliver me from every evil attack and will bring me safely into his heavenly Kingdom. All glory to God forever and ever! Amen.

What Does Living in Great Expectation Look Like?

1. Looking Up for Christ's Second Coming

Acts 1:11 (NLT) ¹¹ “Men of Galilee,” they said, “why are you standing here staring into heaven? Jesus has been taken from you into heaven, but someday he will return from heaven in the same way you saw him go!”

Matthew 24:42–44 (NLT) ⁴² “So you, too, must keep watch! For you don't know what day your Lord is coming. ⁴³ Understand this: If a homeowner knew exactly when a burglar was coming, he would keep

watch and not permit his house to be broken into. ⁴⁴ You also must be ready all the time, for the Son of Man will come when least expected.

Matthew 24:27;30-31 (NLT) ²⁷ For as the lightning flashes in the east and shines to the west, so it will be when the Son of Man comes.³⁰ And then at last, the sign that the Son of Man is coming will appear in the heavens, and there will be deep mourning among all the peoples of the earth. And they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. ³¹ And he will send out his angels with the mighty blast of a trumpet, and they will gather his chosen ones from all over the world—from the farthest ends of the earth and heaven.

Hebrews 9:28b (NLT) He will come again, not to deal with our sins, but to bring salvation to all who are eagerly waiting for him.
