

**WE MUST FACE WHO WE
REALLY ARE (JOSHUA. 2:1)**

GUILTY, UNHIDDEN, AND IN
NEED OF MERCY

WHAT RAHAB KNEW:

GOD DRIED THE RED SEA.

GOD CRUSHED EGYPT.

GOD DESTROYED OTHER FORTIFIED CITIES.

GOD PROMISED THE LAND TO HIS PEOPLE.

**“THE LORD YOUR GOD, HE IS GOD IN THE
HEAVENS ABOVE AND ON THE EARTH
BENEATH.” (JOSHUA 2:11)**

**WE MUST RECOGNIZE WHAT'S
COMING (JOSHUA 2:8:8-11)**

GOD'S JUDGMENT, NOT BAD
LUCK OR MISFORTUNE

RAHAB'S RESPONSE TO WHAT'S COMING:

- SHE RISKS EVERYTHING.
- SHE HIDES GOD'S PEOPLE.
- SHE DEFIES JERICHO'S KING.
- SHE TIES THE CORD.
- SHE STAYS PUT IN FAITH.

By faith Rahab the prostitute did not perish with those who were disobedient, because she had given a friendly welcome to the spies.

Hebrews 11:31

WE MUST ABANDON CHEAP
(JOSHUA 2:4-6; 11-16; 17-21)

SHE BELONGED TO GOD'S PEOPLE.

SHE BECAME PART OF GOD'S STORY.

SHE BECAME THE MOTHER OF BOAZ.

THE GREAT-GRANDMOTHER OF KING DAVID.

AND ULTIMATELY—**A MATRIARCH OF THE MESSIAH**

**WE MUST CONTINUE TO WEAR OUR
REDEMPTION (JOSHUA 6:22-25)**

**RAHAB THE PROSTITUTE IS HELD UP
— NOT TO REVISIT HER SHAME —
BUT TO HIGHLIGHT GOD'S MERCY.**
