



Nehemiah's chief concern is the image and name of God.




Nehemiah's fear is not a hindrance to the work, it is a reminder that the work is dependent on God.



Nehemiah's heart is broken for the same thing that breaks God's heart.




It is only when we have committed ourselves to the Lord in prayer and fasting that we will be able to respond when given the opportunity.



The impending problem should not be what drives us to pray. The power and glory of God should be the thing that drives us to our knees.




Nehemiah backed up his prayers with faithful planning.




It is not our merit or our effort that will earn the hand of God, but it is His grace being extended towards us through His Son that makes it possible for Him to use us in incredible ways.
