### How is our world similar to Daniel's World?

- 1. We are exiles awaiting deliverance (1 Pt 1:1, 17; 2:11; Phil 3:20).
- 2. We serve the same sovereign God (Mal. 3:6; James 1:17).
- 3. Our culture has virtually no expectations of morality (1 Pt. 4:3-4).
- 4. Engaging in certain activities would demonstrate sinful devotion and assimilation (1 John 2:15-17).
