Who is the Holy Spirit?

- The Holy Spirit is mentioned in 21 of the 39 OT book for a total of 79 times. He is seen from creation (Gen 1:2) through Malachi 2:15. He appears most frequently in Isaiah (15x), Ezekiel (15x), Numbers (7x), Judges (7x), I Samuel (7x), and Psalms (5x).
- The Holy Spirit is mentioned in all but four of the NT books for a total of 245 times. He appears most frequently in Acts (56x), Romans (28x) and 1 Corinthians (22x).
- With over 320 references in the Scriptures, the Holy Spirit is a dominant theme in the sacred text.

The Holy Spirit as a Person

1. The "other" Comforter - John 14:16

2. The personal trait of intellect.

- He counsels. Isa 11:2
- He writes. 2 Tim 3:16; 2 Peter 1:21
- He speaks. Romans 8:26; John 14:26, 1 Cor 2:13
- He possesses a mind. Romans 8:27, 1 Cor 2:10-13

The Holy Spirit as a Person

3. The personality trait of will.

- He regenerates. John 3:7-8; Titus 3:5
- He directs. Acts 16:6-7
- He gives gifts. 1 Cor 12:11
- 4. The personal trait of emotion.
 - *He loves. Gal 5:22*
 - He grieves. Eph 4:30
 - He experiences joy. 1 Thess 1:6
 - He can be insulted. Heb 10:29

The Holy Spirit as God.

1. Attributions

- Paul compares the Holy Spirit directly to God. Acts 5
- God's word in the OT is same as the Holy Spirit's words in the NY. Psalm 95:8-11 & Heb 3:7-11
- God's people are the "temple of God" because the Holy Spirit dwells in them. - 1 Cor 6:19 & Romans 8:9-11
- Jesus states that to sin against the Holy Spirit is blasphemy. Only God can be blasphemed. Mark 3:29
- Jesus's statement of Trinitarian equality. Matt 28:19
- Paul's statement of Trinitarian equality. 2 Cor 13:14
- John's statement of Trinitarian equality. Rev 1:4-5


