Spiritual Gifts

Romans 12:6a “Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us...”

“**Gifts**” = charismata, charisma (singular)

(Charis = Grace)

Spiritual Gifts

1 Corinthians 12:1 “Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be ignorant.”

“Spiritual gifts” = pneumatikos

(Pneuma = Spirit)

What are the gifts? Where in the NT?

Ephesians 4:11 “And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers...”

Gifts: Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Pastor-Teacher.

What are the gifts? Where in the NT?

1 Corinthians 12:8-10 for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.

Gifts: wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, miracles, prophecy, discerning of spirits, tongues, interpretation of tongues.

What are the gifts? Where in the NT?

1 Corinthians 12:27-28 “Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. 28 And God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues...”

Gifts: helps, administrations.

What are the gifts? Where in the NT?

Romans 12:6-8 “Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; 7 or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; 8 he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.”

Gifts: Ministry, teaching, exhortation, giving, leading, and mercy.

What are the gifts? Where in the NT?

1 Peter 4:10-11 “As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. 11 If anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.”

Gifts: “Speaking” and “Ministering or Serving”

What are the gifts? Where in the NT?

Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Pastor-Teacher, Teacher, Wisdom, Knowledge, Faith, Miracles, Healings, Prophecy, Discerning of spirits, Tongues, Interpretation of Tongues, Serving, Exhortation, Giving, Leadership, Mercy, Helps and Administration.

Who has been given a gift? Every believer.

1 Peter 4:10-11 “As each one has received a gift...”

1 Cor. 12:7 “But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all...”

1 Cor. 12:11 “But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.”



Are all the gifts still functioning today?

Acts 1:21-22 “Therefore, of these men who have accompanied us all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us, 22 beginning from the baptism of John to that day when He was taken up from us, one of these must become a witness with us of His resurrection.”

Are all the gifts still functioning today?

1 Corinthians 15:8 “Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.”

Are all the gifts still functioning today?

2 Corinthians 12:12 “Truly the signs of an apostle were accomplished among you with all perseverance, in signs and wonders and mighty deeds.”

Are all the gifts still functioning today?

Hebrews 2:1-5 Therefore we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away. 2 For if the word spoken through angels proved steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just reward, 3 how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him, 4 God also bearing witness both with signs and wonders, with various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to His own will?

Are all the gifts still functioning today?

- ➔ **No Longer Functioning:** Apostle, Prophet, Wisdom and Knowledge, Miracles and Healings, Discerning of spirits, Tongues, and Interpretation of Tongues.
- ➔ **Functioning Today:** Evangelist, Pastor-Teacher, Teacher, Helps/Assistance, Administration, Encouragement/Exhortation, Giving, Mercy.

Why do I have a gift?

Ephesians 4:11-12 And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ.

1 Corinthians 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all.

1 Corinthians 14:12 Even so you, since you are zealous for spiritual gifts, let it be for the edification of the church that you seek to excel.
