ICEBREAKER: What is your favorite story to tell? Why is that?

In any good movie or story, there is always conflict. What are some examples of conflict in these stories: Star Wars, Harry Potter, & Mulan? Can you think of any other famous examples?

Why is conflict essential for a good story? What kinds of conflict do people face in life?

On the other side of conflict, there is a conclusion. Everyone faces conflict – big and small. Furthermore, everyone experiences conclusion – internal or external. This is where we discover the power of story. The churchy term for this is “testimony.”

READ: 1 Timothy 6:12 (God’s Word Translation) & Psalm 119:24 (ESV)

These verses speak to the power of our testimony. As you read this text, find a way to share it with the whole group – screen share or present onto a television.

- What is the theme of these two verses?
- What lessons can we learn from these verses?

Ask for 2-3 people from the group to share their testimony.

Many stories are still being told. What are some conflicts you’re facing right now? When you overcome these conflicts, you will have a powerful story. Keep pushing! Keep going!

In what ways can our stories make a difference?
