Read Genesis 16-29 Interpretation Multiple things are happening in this section of Scripture. Describe them in your own words.
Observation FYI - Ben-oni means "Son of my sorrow" Benjamin means "Son of my right hand"
List the major losses of Jacob/Israel.
Why do you think Israel changed the name of his son?
Why is the sin of Reuben inserted here? What do you think the purpose of his sin was? How do you see Jacob's response?
What is the importance of stating the twelve sons of Jacob?

Application

How do you find comfort in times of loss?

How are we to respond to the sins of our children?

Read Genesis 36 Interpretation/Observation

What is being described and why is it important?
