To be a Christian in Peter's time meant facing uncertain and unpleasant experiences from the surrounding world. A person might well hesitate to join a Christian group for fear of the consequences or quietly opt out because the demands were too great. One of Peter's aims in his letter, then, was to encourage his readers by giving them grounds for solid hope in the ultimate future so that they might face the immediate future with equanimity, courage and even joy.
