The Water-Walking Savior

1. Meets you in the storm.

2. Speaks to you from the storm.

“Take courage. It is I. Don’t be afraid.”

How does God speak to us?

His Word

But now, this is what the LORD says: “...Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze. For I am the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior. (Is 43:1–3a)

3. Strengthens your faith through the storm.

“You of little faith. Why did you doubt.” (Mt 14:31)

Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. (Jas 1:2–4)

4. Reveals Himself to you through the storm.

“Intending to pass by” (Mk 6:48)

“Truly You are the Son of God” (Mt 14:33)

Faith is RECOGNIZING who Jesus is and RESPONDING to Him with the appropriate trust, surrender, obedience, and worship.
