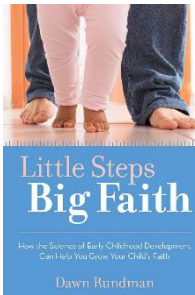
MARCH MISSION OF THE MONTH IS SLEEP IN HEAVENLY PEACE
