INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING IN EACH KIT: 1 dark color, light-weight bath size towel (between 20"x40" and 52"x27"), 2 or 3 bath-size bars of soap equaling 8-9 oz., any brand, in original wrapping, 1 adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging, 1 sturdy comb, remove packaging, 1 metal nail clippers (attached file optional), remove packaging.
