


Here is bread, here is wine, Christ is with us, he is with us. Break the bread, taste the wine Christ is with us here.

*Refrain:* In this bread, there is healing, in this cup is life forever. In this moment, by the spirit, Christ is with us here.


Here is grace, here is peace, Christ is with us, he is with us. Know his grace, find his peace, feast on Jesus here.

Here we are, joined as one, Christ is with us, he is with us. We'll proclaim till he comes, Jesus crucified. *Refrain* 


