

# “Redeemed from the Curse”

It seems when we as Christians have problems, circumstances, or bad reports, we have a tendency to be struck with spiritual amnesia; we act like we don't know God, His promises given to us, or the power and authority that He has given us. We act defeated instead of victorious, hopeless instead of hopeful, and talk about our problems, issues, and the devil more than declaring faith in our God and His Word!!

## **Psalm 103:1-5 NKJV:**

Bless the Lord, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name!

<sup>2</sup> Bless the Lord, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits:

<sup>3</sup> Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases,

<sup>4</sup> Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies,

<sup>5</sup> Who satisfies your mouth with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

**James 1:5 NKJV:** But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.

**Curse:** 'To invoke evil, calamity, injury, sickness, disease, destruction, doomed to punishment, or ruin upon.'

**Galatians 3:10-14 NKJV:** <sup>10</sup> For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse; for it is written, “Cursed *is* everyone who does not continue in all things which are written in the book of the law, to do them.” <sup>11</sup> But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God *is* evident, for “the just shall live by faith.” <sup>12</sup> Yet the law is not of faith, but “the man who does them shall live by them.”

<sup>13</sup> Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, “Cursed *is* everyone who hangs on a tree”), <sup>14</sup> that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

## #1. What is the curse of the Law? **Deuteronomy 28:15-68 NKJV**

### **Examples:**

**Deuteronomy 28:15-16 NKJV:** <sup>15</sup> “But it shall come to pass, if you do not obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe carefully all His commandments and His statutes which I command you today, that all these curses will come upon you and overtake you:

<sup>16</sup> “Cursed *shall you be* in the city and cursed *shall you be* in the country.

**Deuteronomy 28:22 NKJV:** The LORD will strike you with consumption, with fever, with inflammation, with severe burning fever, with the sword, with scorching, and with mildew; they shall pursue you until you perish.

**Deuteronomy 28:27-29 NKJV:** <sup>27</sup> The LORD will strike you with the boils of Egypt, with tumors, with the scab, and with the itch, from which you cannot be healed. <sup>28</sup> The LORD will strike you with madness and blindness and confusion of heart. <sup>29</sup> And you shall grope at noonday, as a blind man gropes in darkness; you shall not prosper in your ways; you shall be only oppressed and plundered continually, and no one shall save *you*.

**Deuteronomy 28:38-39 NKJV:** <sup>38</sup> “You shall carry much seed out to the field but gather little in, for the locust shall consume it. <sup>39</sup> You shall plant vineyards and tend *them*, but you shall neither drink *of* the wine nor gather the *grapes*; for the worms shall eat them.

**Deuteronomy 28:47-48 NKJV:** <sup>47</sup> “Because you did not serve the LORD your God with joy and gladness of heart, for the abundance of everything, <sup>48</sup> therefore you shall serve your enemies, whom the LORD will send against you, in hunger, in thirst, in nakedness, and in need of everything; and He will put a yoke of iron on your neck until He has destroyed you.

**Deuteronomy 28:58-61 NKJV:** <sup>58</sup> “If you do not carefully observe all the words of this law that are written in this book, that you may fear this glorious and awesome name, THE LORD YOUR GOD, <sup>59</sup> then the LORD will bring upon you and your descendants extraordinary plagues—great and prolonged plagues—and serious and prolonged sicknesses. <sup>60</sup> Moreover He will bring back on you all the diseases of Egypt, of which you were afraid, and they shall cling to you. <sup>61</sup> Also every sickness and every plague, which *is* not written in this Book of the Law, will the LORD bring upon you until you are destroyed.

**#2.** If you have accepted Jesus as your Lord, you're **REDEEMED** from every curse!!!

**A.** To 'Redeem' means: 'To purchase and buy back that which belonged to you; to rescue from loss; by payment of price, to recover from the power of another.'

**1 Peter 1:17-19 NKJV:** <sup>17</sup> And if you call on the Father, who without partiality judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves throughout the time of your stay *here* in fear; <sup>18</sup> knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, *like* silver or gold, from your aimless conduct *received* by tradition from your fathers, <sup>19</sup> but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

**#3.** Redeemed from sin, sickness and disease, satan and satanic powers, and poverty.

**A.** Sin:

**Romans 5:12-17 NKJV:** <sup>12</sup> Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned— <sup>13</sup> (For until the law sin was in the world, but sin is not imputed when there is no law. <sup>14</sup> Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those who had not sinned according to the likeness of the transgression of Adam, who is a type of Him who was to come. <sup>15</sup> But the free gift *is* not like the offense. For if by the one man's offense many died, much more the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many. <sup>16</sup> And the gift *is* not like *that which came* through the one who sinned. For the judgment *which came* from one *offense resulted* in condemnation, but the free gift *which came* from many offenses *resulted* in justification. <sup>17</sup> For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.)

**Romans 8:1-2 NKJV:** *There is* therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. <sup>2</sup> For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

## B. Sickness and Disease:

**Matthew 8:16-17 NKJV:** <sup>16</sup> When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, <sup>17</sup> that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying:

“He Himself took our infirmities  
And bore *our* sicknesses.”

**1 Peter 2:24 NKJV:** who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

**Acts 10:38 NKJV:** how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

## C. Satan and satanic powers:

**Colossians 1:13-14 NKJV:** <sup>13</sup> He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love, <sup>14</sup> in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

**Luke 10:18-20 NKJV:** <sup>18</sup> And He said to them, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. <sup>19</sup> Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. <sup>20</sup> Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.”

## D. Poverty:

**2 Corinthians 8:9 NKJV:** For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich. (**Malachi 3:8-11; Genesis 14:18-20**)
