1. Read 1 Corinthians 13:13 together. The greatest is LOVE.
2. Reflect on what you heard in the third sermon. We need to build a heart of love.
3. Reflect: do you feel loved by Jesus, family, other Christians?
4. What is your love language?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7
 - a. Reflect: is this how you love others?
 - b. Are people patient and kind?

If we are to build a heart of love, we need to know three things:

1. Love is a giving thing.
 - a. READ John 3:16; John 4:9-12
 - b. Reflect: Is this of central importance?
 - What has God given you?
 - What do you need to give?
 - c. How can we develop and plan to intentionally love others?
 - d. Read 1 John 4:16-18. Discuss.
 - e. Suggestion: When we love others, our hearts are built up.
If we want to build a heart of love, we need to know that love.
2. Love seeks to heal.
 - a. Read Isaiah 61:1, Matthew 8:1-3.
 - b. Discuss: do you need healing? Are you broken hearted?
 - c. Pray for each other.
 - d. Read 1 Corinthians 12:28. Do you believe that the church has power to heal?
 - e. Share stories of healing.

3. If we want to build a heart of love, we need to know that...
Love is not silent.
- a. Read John 1:14. What does this mean?
 - b. Read John 16:33 How does this build a heart of love?
 - c. Read John 7:46 How did Jesus speak differently?
 - d. Further study: 1 Corinthians 13
Proverbs 15:4
Proverbs 18:4,21
Proverbs 16:24
 - e. Read James 3:3-6. What is the power of the tongue?
 - f. Read Ephesians 4:15. This builds a heart of love.
