### **BIG IDEA: The gospel regathers what rebellion scattered.**

#### **Read Genesis 11:1-4**

1. The Tower of Babel was an attempt to build a tower that would give direct access to Yahweh. The people thought they could get to God on their terms, not his. How are you tempted to get to God and worship God on your terms instead of his?

#### **Read Genesis 7:5**

2. God came down to mock the efforts of these people to build a tower to the heavens. The reality is that God is big and we are small. What happens when we confuse and forget this reality?

#### **Read Genesis 7:6-7**

3. The people were united in their rebellion against God. How do we make sure that we are unified around the right things? Around the gospel and gospel implications?

#### **Read Genesis 7:8-9**

4. Sin brings confusion and destruction. It scatters us. How have you seen sin do this in your life?

#### **Read Deuteronomy 32:8-9**

5. The Lord's portion is his people, not the idolatrous nations. How does Jesus' work on the cross make it possible for us to be part of his people? How does being part of "God's people" impact how you live?

#### **Read Acts 2:1-12**

6. Pentecost is the reversal of the Tower of Babel. The gospel is uniting what rebellion divided. How does the gospel bring us into one new nation? One people together? How can we better live this out as a church?
