- Dietrich Bonhoeffer said, "Flight into the invisible is a denial of the call. A community of Jesus which seeks to hide itself has ceased to follow him." Where do you need to repent for not shining a light into our dark world?

Matthew 5:16

- Our purpose is to magnify God, not ourselves. Where are you particularly tempted to magnify yourself rather than God?
- How can you humbly magnify God and not yourself this week?
 - Easter invite stats:
 - 35% of unchurched people would be likely to accept a personal invite to church on any given week while 82% of the unchurched population would accept a personal invite to an Easter service
 - 2% of people who attend church will do so because of a church advertisement compared to 86% who attend because they were invited by someone they know
