BIG IDEA: Jesus is the Lord of life and death.

Read Mark 5:21-24

Read Mark 5:25-29

- 5. What kind of desperate situation was this woman in?
- 6. What did she do out of her desperation?
- 7. How was this an act of faith?
- 8. How did her fear of not being able to reach Jesus overshadow her fear of the people?
- 9. Have you ever been at a point where you knew Jesus was your only hope?
- 10. How is this woman's faith and action comparable to our coming to Christ?

Read Mark 5:30-34

- 11. Why does Jesus ask, "who touched me?".
- 12. Why is her public profession important?
- 13. Why is our public profession important?
- 14. How did her private faith become a public profession of faith?
- 15. In verse 34, what is significant about Jesus calling her "daughter"?
- 16. Why do we fear death and disease?
- 17. What does the death and resurrection of Jesus prove to us as believers?

Read Mark 5:35-43

- 18. What must this news had been like for Jairus?
- 19. How do you think Jairus received Jesus' words?
- 20. When death crushes our soul, what do Jesus' words mean to us?
- 21. How do Jesus' words show His power over death?
- 22. How do these scenes show us that all of our greatest fears ultimately fear Jesus?
