# **BIG IDEA: We Hope in the Warrior King**

#### **Ground Rules:**

1. This is a letter written to 7 churches.

- 2. There is almost nothing new here.
- 3. The book is full of imagery and is NOT chronological: This is apocalyptic literature. That does not mean the end of world literature. It means "that which was concealed is being revealed." In keeping with this style of writing, each image has a meaning stars = angels. Dragon = Satan, lamp stands/torches = churches. And the appearance of these images isn't always in chronological order. One theologian describes it as walking through an art gallery. Nothing is arranged in chronology, but more so by style and content.
- 4. We are in the End Times: Heb. 1:1-2 Long ago God spoke to our ancestors by the prophets at different times and in different ways. <sup>2</sup> In these last days, he has spoken to us by his Son. God has appointed Him heir of all things and made the universe through him.
- 5. We must read with humility: If your understanding of Revelation is dependent upon the current news cycle for your interpretation you're wrong. How do I know? Give it a week and you'll see. Everyone who has used the news cycle to interpret Revelation has been proven wrong because they rely on speculation. Speculation is the enemy of biblical interpretation.
