**BIG IDEA: JESUS USES THE UNUSABLE**

**Read Exodus 2:1-5, 10**

3. How does Moses point us to Jesus here?
4. Why should we not be shocked when we encounter hardship as we are helping others be delivered from their spiritual and physical problems?
5. Moses is raised as a pagan under an Egyptian Pharaoh. What does this show us about the kind of people God uses?

**Read Exodus 2:11-12, 15**

6. How is Moses the opposite of Jesus here?
7. How is Jesus able to use messed up people like Moses and like you?
8. How can you apply this?

**Read Exodus 2:23-25**

9. How are these verses some of the most comforting verses in the Bible? Focus on the four actions of God in vv. 24, 25.

**Read Exodus 3:1-8, 10-12**

10. What is the normal way that God communicates?
11. What does Moses' response to a holy God teach us about how we should approach God?
12. How does God's plan for his peoples' deliverance here point us to his ultimate deliverance for his people?
13. Why is Moses able to do this task that God has called him to? How does that impact us being faithful to take the gospel out?
14. What does Moses call himself? What does God call Moses?
15. What does God call those who are in Christ? How does that change how you live?
