Big Idea: The King is worshipped and betrayed

## Matthew 26:1-16

What is significant about the oil the woman anointed Jesus with?

- What things most elicit worship (like the woman with the alabaster jar) or most stir affection for Jesus in your life?
- What were the disciples (and/or Judas') responses to the woman's actions? Why did they react this way?
- What is Jesus' response to the disciples? What does he mean in verses 10-11?
- Why was Judas called "the Dagger Man?"
- Why did the disciples not see that he would be the one to betray Jesus?

### Matthew 26:17-30

- What do we learn about Jesus by the way he treats Judas?
- What tempts you to betray Jesus? How do you betray him?
- What causes you to be self-focused to where you miss what Jesus is clearly doing or saying?
- The disciples are shocked when Jesus says they are capable of betrayal and abandonment and then they do it. What sin(s) have you thought you were incapable of committing and then you did it? How did you repent?

### Matthew 26:31-35

- How have you experienced the grace of Jesus in your sin or betrayal of Jesus?
- What does the Lord's Supper declare about our worth to Jesus?
- What is Jesus worth?
