BIG IDEA: Salvation is through judgment.

Read Genesis 7:11-16

1. God gave them one door of salvation, the entrance into the ark. What is our one door of salvation and how do we enter into that door? Also, God shut them in the ark, their salvation. How does God seal our salvation too? How does this change how you live?

Read Genesis 7:21-23

2. Why does sin bring death? How have you experienced this or seen glimpses of this in your own life? Why does it then bring you hope that Jesus died in the place of sinners?

Read Genesis 8:6-11

3. Noah wants to know if judgment has ended and God provides for him an olive branch - the sign that there is now peace. Peace came through judgment. How can you have peace with God?

Read Genesis 8:20-21

4. The scandal of the Bible isn't that God would flood the world and kill almost everybody - the scandal is that he is willing to save anybody. How has God been kind and gracious towards you?

Read Genesis 9:11-13

5. God promised through the rainbow, or "war bow", to turn judgement towards heaven, not earth. Pointing to the day when Jesus will take on the judgement for sin. The day when Jesus, at the cross, took the war bow of heaven - pointed it at himself - and fired the arrow of God's wrath against sin into his own chest. Why does Jesus have to do this for us to be saved? How can we worship him for what he has done?
6. If you genuinely are repenting and believing the gospel, Jesus has been judged and died, for your sin. It is forgiven! It is done! How can we live in freedom of his grace even when we sin, just like Noah did, right after the covenant God made with him?
