Big Idea: Jesus Sees His People

Icebreaker: What are some things that have drastically changed in your lifetime?

Exodus 1:6-10, 15-16, 20-22

The new King of Egypt fears how numerous and powerful the Israelites are becoming and commands the killing of newborn boys. Though God has promised deliverance, it seems hopeless in their current circumstances, the Israelites are under bondage to the Egyptians.
