BIG IDEA: The son who saves is humiliated and exalted

Read Genesis 41:14-16

- Joseph is left in the dungeon where the cupbearer forgot him.
- Joseph is brought out of the dungeon to help interpret Pharaoh's dream.
- Joseph tells Pharaoh that he is not able to interpret his dream but it is God who will be able to give a favorable interpretation.
- **How do we see that the pit was a part of God's plan for Joseph? How can you worship God knowing that he can use the pit to fulfill His sovereign purposes?**

Read Genesis 41:25-32

- Joseph is faithful to give the correct interpretation of the dream.
- He could have lied but he chose to be honest with Pharaoh.
- *Speak the truth boldly, but humbly. Honestly, but not angrily. - Dayton*
- **What is an area of your life that you are tempted to not tell the whole truth or outright lie? Why is that an area you struggle to tell the truth?**

Read Genesis 41:33-42

- Joseph tells Pharaoh he needs to appoint someone to oversee the land during these 14 years.
- Pharaoh appoints Joseph to be the person to oversee this project while putting him in a position of power.
- Joseph was brought out of the pit and exalted. This shows us a clear picture of Christ.
- **Do you see that God has placed you in the position you are in for a reason? How can that change how you look at your day-to-day life?**

Read Genesis 41:53-57

- Joseph is able to help Egypt and the surrounding nations survive the famine.
- Joseph is able to help sustain life among the people for a time. Jesus is able to provide the nations what they need more than food, salvation for their souls.
- **How does believing that Jesus is the ultimate Savior change how you live today?**
