- 6. Why can Jesus make a claim like this in verse 19?
- 7. What is the difference between spiritual consumerism and submission?

#### Read John 3:1-6

- 8. What do we know about the Pharisees?
- 9. What do we know about Nicodemus?
- 10. How does Nicodemus' walking in the darkness to come to Jesus, a picture of his spiritual state?
- 11. How do you think Nicodemus has viewed salvation up to this point?
